



MultiTreat 7.0 Computer Radionic Treatment Program

Multi-Treatment & Treatment Editor (MT & TED) Manual

Please note that icons and features may vary depending on whether MT 7 is used on a Windows or Mac operating system. The installation instructions also differ.

To begin



Double click on the Blue MultiTreat 7 icon
(Windows - If you have mounted MT to Dos Box yourself – Click on the Dos Box icon)

Command prompt will tell you either that there are no treatments enqueued, or it will ask if you wish to start treatments.

Enter 'Y' or 'N'

Enter Y (Yes) if you wish treatments to go ahead and press return

Enter N (No) if treatments are already done for the day and you wish to place an additional or emergency treatment.

If new treatments are **not** needed that day then store the information in Treatment Editor (**TED**) for automatic broadcast operation on the next day- see page 3.

Treatments can be entered directly into TED for broadcast the **next** day, except when the MT broadcasts are in operation. Opening the Treatment Editor (red Icon) at the same time as MultiTreat may cause the program to crash. If this does occur use the MultiTreat Lock State Reset (Windows) which you will find within the MT files in your program files. This has a blue icon with 2 interlocking grey cogs.

Information regarding **new** treatments, to commence **that day** is entered in the data input area at the bottom of the blue MT screen.

To add treatment information onto the MultiTreat data file.

Type 'treat' after the flashing >

The following prompts will appear in the input box:

Target name ?	>Target Name or leave blank	up to 22 digits
Rate 1	>Treatment Numerical Identification	up to 20 digits

<i>Each level may be abbreviated to the first three characters. These first three letters are sufficient for identification. Any combination of levels can be used, or use NON-specified for all levels.</i>	

Treatment time ?	>Length of treatment in minutes	up to 500 minutes
Total treatments ?	>Number of treatments	up to 3,200
Rate 2 ?	Numerical identification – a second treatment, if there is one. There can be up to 15. When there are no additional treatments PRESS ENTER to complete i.e. initiate treatment/s entered.	

The programme will then return to the command prompt. Flashing >

Treatment information will be logged into the programme for treatment each day until completion of the final day's treatment. If the practitioner starts the Multitreat 7.0 programme once a day then effectively the broadcasts equal that number of days.

Progress of treatments is updated every 10 seconds on screen.

TO VIEW AND/OR ALTER RECORDS



To view or alter any records after entry and/or mt treatment entry open the Treatment EDitor (**TED**).

Note: TED should only be launched when the MultiTreat (MT) program is closed.

Type **h** for help.

Instruction options, as listed below will be on screen.
